Counterfeit products are commonly thought to be fake luxury products or illegally copied music, movies or software.

Nowadays counterfeiters also make pharmaceuticals, food, liquor, toys and spare parts. Using these products can harm or kill you or your loved ones.

Dealing in counterfeit products is a crime that can carry severe penalties – up to two years of imprisonment.

How do I know if the product I'm buying is counterfeit?

Some indicators to watch for:

- the price is much lower than average
- spelling mistakes on the product or packaging
- products normally sold in packages being sold individually
- shoddy appearance of the product or package
