



# Recording Industry In Numbers - Terms and Conditions

## 1. Access to Publication

After the release date and following receipt of any payment due in full, you will be provided with an FTP link and password to access "The Recording Industry In Numbers" (the "Publication") in an electronic Adobe PDF format. The link and password is for your use only and may not be shared with anyone other than employees and officers within your company, partnership, sole proprietorship or other unincorporated business organisation (the "Company") and even in those circumstances shall only be shared to the extent necessary to allow efficient access to the Publication by the Company. If your purchase is not made on behalf of a company, partnership, sole proprietorship or other unincorporated business organisation and is for your own private and non-business use, please note the download link and password is for your personal use only and must not be shared with any other person.

## 2. Grant of Licence

IFPI grants the Company a non-exclusive, non-transferable licence for use of the Publication within the Company according to the terms and conditions set out below. Where the Publication is for your own private and non-business use, IFPI grants you a non-exclusive, non-transferable licence for use of the Publication according to the same terms and conditions. For the avoidance of doubt, IFPI retains all copyright and other rights in and to the Publication and neither you nor the Company or its employees or officers acquire any rights, title or interest in or to the Publication other than as set out in these terms and conditions.

## 3. Permitted Uses

Where you are accessing the Publication on behalf of the Company, you may:

- Make temporary local electronic copies of the Publication solely to ensure the efficient use of the Publication by the Company;
- Save the Publication to the hard disk of a Company computer and place a copy of the Publication on the Company's intranet, electronic library system or similar information system, provided access is restricted to employees and officers of the

Company only and the terms and conditions of the use of the Publication are made clear to all employees and officers of the Company;

- Make, or permit to be made, no more than two print outs of the complete Publication for use within the Company and storage in a hard copy Company library or similar;
- Allow any employee in the Company to access the Publication;
- Allow any employee to print extracts (to a maximum of 10 pages) from the Publication; and
- Include, or allow employees and officers of the Company to include, information from the Publication in presentations or other documents or published work provided IFPI is properly credited.

#### **4. Prohibitions and Restrictions**

In particular and without limitation you may not, and must not permit the Company or its employees or officers to:

- Alter any part of the Publication or remove any proprietary notices; or
- Sub-license, lease, rent or sell the Publication or copies of it in full or in part.
